## **Student presentations: Portuguese cities preparatory activity**

### **1. Introduction**

As part of the pre-departure preparation for the Erasmus+ mobility to Portugal, students worked in groups to explore and present different Portuguese cities. The activity enhanced cultural awareness of the host country while stimulating curiosity, interest, and motivation in view of the mobility experience.

### **2. Objectives**

- Develop research and synthesis skills.
- Strengthen the use of digital tools for multimedia presentations.
- Increase cultural knowledge of the Portuguese cities included in the mobility itinerary.
- Promote teamwork and creativity.
- Foster motivation and active participation during the preparatory phase.

### **3. Skills acquired**

Students acquired and developed:

- Digital skills: advanced use of PowerPoint and Canva to create engaging visual presentations.
- Intercultural skills: knowledge of historical, artistic, gastronomic, and traditional aspects of Portuguese cities.
- Transversal skills: teamwork, problem solving, creativity, time management, and oral presentation abilities.
- Communication skills: content organization, clear exposition, and information sharing in a collective context.

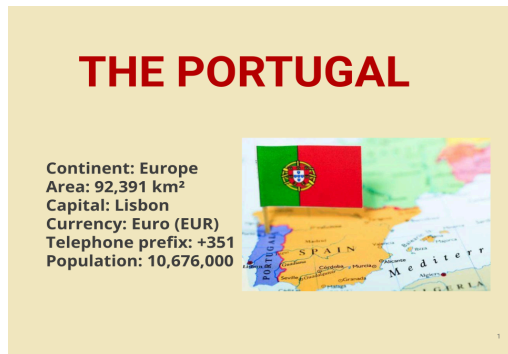
### **4. Activity description**
